1. Call to Order and Pledge of Allegiance

Mr. Blackwood called the meeting to order at 4:32 p.m.

2. Public Comment - None.

3. Discussion and Possible Action to Approve the Meeting Minutes Dated February 21, 2018

Mr. Grosch stated the Committee's recommendations were not prioritized. Mr. Blackwood stated Item #5 lists the priorities but numbers #2 and #3 seem to be the same thing to put something along Hwy G. He said one should be the recreational routes. There were no other comments. **A motion was made and seconded, (R. Grosch, J. Vitale) to direct the Clerk to adjust item #3 to say the recreation routes.** Motion Passed: 3-For, 0-Against.

4. Update on the Pewaukee School District's Bike Rodeo

Mr. Vitale stated VeloCity and the Village Police Department are participating in this family event. He said they are capping the amount of kids to approximately 200 since this is their first year. It will be held on a school night. Next year it may be on a weekend depending on how well it is received. There will be a bike safety check such as assuring there is proper air pressure in their tires. There will be short safety video for the entire family and afterwards the kids can use the remaining 25 minutes to go through eight skill stations. Mr. Vitale stated they are in need of volunteers. He said they were also hoping to get some safety manuals donated by the Bike Federation.

5. Discussion Regarding the Creation of a Greenway System Within the City of Pewaukee

Mr. Blackwood commented on the City of Brookfield's greenway system. He said it was a combination of path systems and routes through subdivisions to connect to parks and other natural areas. He said Mr. Clinkenbeard is currently updating the 2050 neighborhood plans. Mr. Grosch stated that would be wonderful to have a path over to the new Sports Complex and Balmer Park. Mr. Grosch said at one time there was a proposal to have a bridge over the river near ProHealth to the County's land, but he wasn't sure how far along that got. Mr. Blackwood stated the County's map shows the path ending at the freeway. He said than it branches off to the West near the intersection of Hwy JJ and Morris Street, and the other piece is where the proposed drug rehab center is in the Village. Mr. Grosch suggested leaving room at the Neumann site to allow for additional needed paths. Mr. Blackwood stated everyone should start thinking about different ideas to discuss at the next meeting.

6. Update Related to the Safety Brochure

Mr. Blackwood stated he believed Mr. Ross had a few items to update. Ms. Tarczewski stated he was also contacting the Bike Federation to make sure there was no copyright infringement. The

members stated if the brochure is ready before the Bike Rodeo it could be given to the school to distribute.

In Mr. Ford's absence this item will be moved to the next agenda for further discussion.

7. Set the Next Meeting Date

The Committee scheduled their next meeting for Wednesday, April 18th at 4:30 p.m.
