1.0 Call to Order and Pledge of Allegiance - Mayor Klein called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

4.0 Presentation of the 2015 Annual Sheriff's Report

Lieutenants B. Ripplinger and P. Beale were present for this item. Lieutenant Ripplinger presented the 2015 Annual Sheriff's Report.

Dan Teske (W244 N4512 Swan Road) stated he was disappointed with the service he has received from the Sheriff's Department. He stated he has made numerous complaints regarding heavy trucking in the area and was told it was up to the discretion of the deputies on duty. He also said he was a victim of burglary, felony theft and mailbox damage and was unsatisfied with how these matters were handled.

5.0 Discussion Regarding Trailer Parking on Apple Tree and Pear Tree Lanes

Ms. Brown stated the neighbors assumed this issue was handled the last time it was discussed at the Common Council level, but she had to explain to them that since no one showed up or sent back any of the postcards supporting the ban of trailer parking on the streets no action was taken.

Mr. Stair stated he was speaking on behalf of Apple Tree Lane only and said there was a big problem with trailer parking on their street. There was additional discussion regarding this matter.

A motion was made and seconded, (J. Kara, C. Brown) to prohibit trailer parking on Pear Tree Lane, Apple Tree Lane and Orchard Court. Motion Passed: 6-For, 0-Against.
