A motion was made and seconded, (S. Bierce, J. Wamser), to approve the Common Council meeting minutes dated January 4, 2016. Motion Passed: 4-For, 0-Against, 2-Abstain (C. Brown, D. Noll).

3.7 Approve Ordinance 16-04 to Repeal and Recreate Section 6.145 of the City of Pewaukee Municipal Code Regarding Garbage and Recycling Services

Mr. Kara stated he agrees with the intent of the ordinance but can't justify fining people. Mayor Klein stated the ordinance is for those who abuse the situation and cause a nuisance. He stated he'd like to see stickers printed to warn people of this violation and keep record of those who are habitual offenders before fining people. Ms. Brown stated she has received many complaints from people in her district regarding people who are leaving their garbage carts in the road. She stated she is in favor of this ordinance. Mr. Bierce stated he received a call from one of his constituents concerned about the ordinance. It was suggested that the City should attempt to work with these individuals that have issues to see if alternate options are available to them, such as up-the-drive service.

A motion was made and seconded (C. Brown, D. Noll) to approve Ordinance 16-04 to repeal and recreate Section 6.145 of the City of Pewaukee Municipal Code regarding garbage and recycling services.
Motion Passed: 4-For, 2-Against (S. Bierce, J. Kara)
