4. Old Business
 - 4.1. Further discussion and possible action on the request from Xylem Water Solutions, USA to operate or reposition fork lifts on Paul Road and Roundy Drive between the two Xylem facilities: There was a discussion and questions for the Xylem representative. Motion by Pjevach, second by Tormey to approve staff recommendation of limiting hours of use from 9-11:30am & 1-3:00pm with strobe lights on vehicles and this is contingent on upon City Attorney weighing in on possible liability issue. Tormey asked if he could amend the Motion to include providing a Certificate of Insurance. Motion passed with 3 in favor and 1 against (Swan).
