City Planner Nick Fuchs, R&R House Project Coordinator Victor Kilpatrick, Waukesha County Sherriff Lt. M. Moonen, City of Pewaukee Alderman Brandon Bergman, Committee Member Christine Piper and City of Pewaukee Administrative Assistant T. Grandinetti.

1. Call to Order and Pledge of Allegiance

Mr. Bergman called the meeting to order at 2:00 pm and requested everyone stand for the Pledge of Allegiance.

2. Public Comment

No public comment.

3. Discussion and Action Regarding Approval of the December 15, 2020 Meeting Minutes.

A motion was made and seconded (C. Piper, M. Moonen) to approve the meeting minutes dated December 15, 2020. Motion Passed: 5-For, 0-Against.

4. Discussion and Possible Action regarding the current project and occupancy status of the R&R House.

Mr. Fuchs stated from a staff standpoint the facility is up and running. Mr. Kilpatrick stated the R&R House officially opened January 29, 2021 and have continued their 24-hour non-crisis line. He said the house was supposed to have their first guest stay but it fell through. Mr. Kilpatrick mentioned he was happy to see staff go through the paces so when they do have their first guest, all staff will be ready. Mr. Kilpatrick stated they have not had any issues with the neighbors and noted they took the cameras down. He said they are continuing monthly Facebook live stream events which highlight different counties in Wisconsin and the veteran resources available to them.

Mr. Fuchs asked if they were still working on getting their first guest to stay in the home. Mr. Kilpatrick stated even though there are three bedrooms, they are limiting it to only two guests due to Covid. He noted the vaccine is not mandatory and the house is following social distancing guidelines including wearing masks in common areas. Prior to guest arriving they will be going through Covid-mandated questions. Mr. Fuchs asked if staff had been vaccinated. Mr. Kilpatrick stated some staff have been vaccinated but it is not required.

Lt. Moonen noted his staff has not been to the house for any issues since opening. Lt. Moonen asked if the house has closed at all since there have not been any guest. Mr. Kilpatrick stated they have not closed and would only close if staff were to get sick.

Lt. Moonen noted he was happy to see that they were able to work things out with the neighbors.

5. Public Comment

Mr. Fuchs stated the Committee will be meeting in person going forward.

A motion was made and seconded (Mr. Moonen, K. Piper) to adjourn the meeting at 2:20pm. Motion Passed: 5-For, 0-Against
